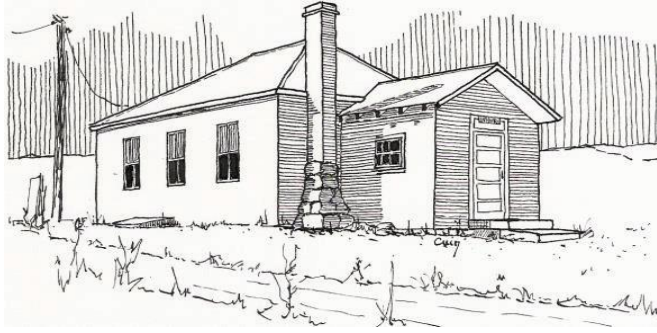


Medlen School Days

PARTICIPATE in the games they played, the songs they sang, and the fun they had!



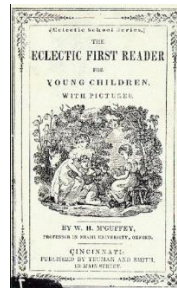

Students will learn our history by living it during each three-day school session at Medlen School:

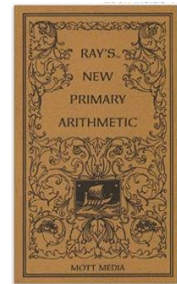


Reading from the McGuffey Reader
